Subject: Important Notice – Changes to C&DD Disposal Effective September 29, 2025

Dear Customer,

We are reaching out to notify you of an important upcoming change regarding the disposal of **Construction and Demolition Debris (C&DD)** waste at SWACO facilities. This change is being implemented in accordance with **Ohio Senate Bill 147**, signed into law on **July 1, 2025**.

Beginning Monday, September 29, 2025, SWACO will officially designate C&DD as separate from **Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)**.

As a result:

- **C&DD will no longer be accepted at SWACO transfer stations.**
- **All C&DD waste must be taken directly to the Franklin County Sanitary Landfill**, where it will be accepted at a rate of **\$39.75 per ton**.
- **Any C&DD loads found delivered to transfer stations will be subject to a \$500.00 prohibited load fee.**

We strongly encourage all haulers and customers to begin preparing now to ensure a smooth transition and avoid disruptions or penalties once this policy takes effect.
